BSE's goal is to consolidate Barcelona as a worldclass center of research, academic education and professional training, with the ultimate goals of informing policy and promoting economic and social wellbeing.

The 2022-23 academic year at the Barcelona School of Economics was filled with activities that highlight the dynamic, face-to-face environment that is essential to our institutional mission.

We welcomed 223 students from 47 countries for our flagship Master's Degree programs, and the BSE Summer Schools and Executive Education courses brought more than 650 people to Barcelona (from 79 countries!) to acquire the latest knowledge and tools for rigorous thinking and technical analysis.

Two international research activities brought around 2,350 academic economists and thought leaders to Barcelona: the 10th edition of the BSE Summer Forum, and the joint Congress of the European Economic Association and European Meeting of the Econometric Society (EEA-ESEM), which BSE hosted for the second time in our history.

While Barcelona will always be the primary location for BSE activities, we recognize that there has been a shift in society's demand for online learning options.

BSE fulfilled this demand in several ways this year. For instance, we delivered several Summer School and Executive Education courses entirely online or in a dual modality with both face-to-face and online participants. We also worked with companies and institutions to provide tailored online training for their employees.

Everything that BSE accomplishes is made possible through the talent and dedication of our professors and staff, as well as the support of our Scientific Council, our Board of Trustees, and our sponsors. Thanks to them, BSE continues to attract talented students and researchers, create opportunities for frontier research and scientific debate, and promote the impact and reputation of Barcelona's economics community worldwide.






