

The president of the European Commission José Manuel Barroso to participate next Tuesday in the global economic forum EEA-ESEM, organized by GSE Barcelona Graduate School of Economics.

What: The president of the European Commission, José Manuel Barroso will participate next week in the 24th Annual Congress of the European Economic Association and the 64th European Meeting of the Econometric Society (<u>EEA-ESEM 09</u>). This joint meeting which will gather together 1800 experts worldwide, is organized by Barcelona Graduate School of Economics (<u>GSE</u>). President José Manuel Barroso will preside the institutional session, along with the minister of Economy and Finances of the Autonomous Government of Catalonia, Antoni Castells, the president of the European Economic Association, Nicholas Stern and the chairman of the Barcelona GSE Andreu Mas-Colell. Following this institutional session, the Bank of England's deputy governor, Charles Bean will address the Schumpeter Lecture entitled 'The great moderation, the great panic and the great contraction".
